

Meeting of College Council JUNE 2020

- Council approved By-Law amendments related to Emergency Licensure.
- Council accepted the Strategic Outcome Monitoring Report as evidence of satisfactory progress in the 2019-2020 period.
- Council approved the scope of practice of an RN who is issued an interim NP license.

Meeting of College Council OCTOBER 2020

- Council voted to discontinue the "Honorary Membership" to better reflect the organizations role as a regulatory body.
- Council made resources available to assist with the production of a new website which will have great benefit to registrants and the public.

MEETING OF COLLEGE COUNCIL MARCH 2021

- Council repealed the call for Resolutions and Motions which takes place at the Annual General Meeting (AGM).
- Memorial University's nurse practitioner (NP) program received a gold-star review and a full seven-year approval from the College. The annual reports for the IEN/re-entry and the BN Programs were positively received by Council.
