




Council Decisions

- Purchased new Building 1033 Topsail Road
- Invested in a new registration and licensing system Alinity
- Started creating a new approach to nominations to Council Competency based board
- Trended and evaluated impact of new licensure pathways
- Initiated the Journey towards the creation of one provincial nursing regulator



Registration Highlights

86% Increase in the number of new registrants (new and re-entry)

- Total # practicing licenses >7700
- Total # NPs = 323
- 580 # of applications from IENs
- 530 # of applications from Canadian RNs

NCLEX pass rate on first attempt

• 94% NL graduates: 49% IENs

NP CNPE pass rate - 100%

Professional Conduct Review

- 51 Allegations filed over the year 24% increase over prior year
- CAC met 12 times to review allegations against 29 registrants
- 4 resolved through QA processes
- 9 Adjudication Tribunals conducted



Practice

- Successful launch of season 1 &2 of our new Podcast > 2700 register for one or more of the 18 sessions 47% increase in engagement from last year.
- CCP program updated, and audit revamped to work within new Alinity registration/licensure database
- >1000 practice calls
- Presentations to approximately 1500 nurses and students
- New resources published variety of topics
